GENERAL INFORMATION

Vendors/Partners:

The doors will open at 7 am for vendors and partner organizations to set up tables. Tables should be set up by 8 am. Please plan to stay for the duration of the event which ends at 11 am. Please check in at the registration desk to receive your name tag and information packet. Carts will be available for use. Tables provided will be 6 feet in length. Each table will have two chairs available.

Business Matchmaking Event:

The Business Matchmaking Event will begin at 9 am and end at 10:30 am. Registrants should check in at the registration desk upon entering the building. All registered participants should proceed to the assigned area on the second floor to find your assigned tables at the scheduled times. The actual schedule for the event will be provided to each registered company in an email.

The matchmaking meetings are brief 10 minute sessions. The sessions are intended to be a fast-paced face-to-face meeting, reminiscent of speed dating, allowing prime contractors and potential subcontractors to discuss capabilities and subcontracting opportunities. 
